A result of the recent parish questionnaire was the identification of five primary goal areas for community focus and improvement. These include:

- **Liturgical** - Participate in liturgical events
- **Outreach** – Serve those in need
- **Education** – Support spiritual formation
- **Fellowship** – Drive social events
- **Maintenance and Operations** - Maintain support of church infrastructure.

The Pastoral Council is an administrative committee responsible for shepherding Saint Joseph Community projects which align with these goal areas. Council members in turn support Father Wayne by actively sponsoring those church projects.

Council Member Responsibilities and Duties

Project sponsorship – active facilitation of projects

Ministry oversight – represent ministries at the council level

Status reporting – track projects and update council on progress

Resource management – work with project coordinators to resource their projects

Recruitment – identify and actively pursue volunteers to help support projects

Council Members will serve a full one year term and commit to attend at least 10 of the 12 monthly meetings and to have representation for any they miss.
